Event -5 DONATE WARMTH (Event Report)


"Greatness is not what you have, it's what you give.

<u>Approx 150 students</u> were obliged to attend this highly informative seminar that was successfully conducted by The Prayas Club of PSIT.



FREE EYE CHECKUP CAMP

On April 29th, 2023, **Eye Lasik House** and **Sarva Samanvay Foundation**, in collaboration with **Prayas Club**, organised a free eye check-up camp at Pranveer Singh Institute of Technology, Kanpur. The event was dedicated to the helping staff (including drivers, conductors, mali, peons, and sweepers) and their family, of the institute. Dhruv Tripathi, Satvik Kumar, and Shivam Saksham, played an instrumental role in organising the camp.



Dr. Kamal Trivedi and his team played a crucial role in organising the basic necessities to start the Eye Check-up camp, which commenced at 11:00 am with the registration of workers. The team of doctors from Eye Lasik House was present at the camp to conduct the checkup of the workers. The eye examination started with the Visual acuity test, where the doctors checked the workers' vision to see how well they could see.



During the test, the doctors instructed them to read letters of different sizes printed on a wall. Each eye was tested separately, and the doctors provided every worker with their test results, required medication, and advice for improving their vision. The camp provided a total of 98 eye checkups from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm, benefiting many workers and their families.



At last 10 workers with the most poor vision were given the glasses they needed. This Free Glasses Distribution was made possible with the contribution from Dhruv Tripathi and Sarva Samanvay Foundation.



• Day 4: On 9th and 10th of October 2023, the species were divided among the members and then we gathered the information and made word files for further procedure.

• Day 5: On October 11th 2023 the details were integrated and the eco map draft was made along with a demo QR code. It comes under a great deal of hard work and experience to find out the efforts put in to make our college campus look so luscious and the seeds of which were planted in the year 2003.





Event Overview:




Event Overview




